SUBJECT: APPOINTMENT TO DOWNTOWN ADVISORY BOARD

ISSUE:

Appointment to Downtown Advisory Board.

RECOMMENDATION

The Council Board and Commission Appointments Committee recommends that Council approve the appointment listed in the Facts and Findings to the Downtown Advisory Board.

BACKGROUND:

Under the Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and the Urban Renewal Agency dated 4/20/2005, creates the Downtown Advisory Board, and states that seven appointments be made by the City Council. The vacancy is for a "special requirement" position of which the candidate must have a business/or be a property owner within the Downtown Parking District. The Council Committee reviewed the applications on file and is recommending the appointment listed in the Facts and Findings section.

FACTS AND FINDINGS:

The Mayor and Council Board and Commission Appointments Committee are making the following recommendation for appointment.

Susan Miller to fill the business/property owner within the Downtown Parking District position and for a three year term expiring 12/31/2014
