Join with your neighbors to make the most of your community. Your neighborhood association fosters relationships between residents and local government to address many neighborhood needs, including traffic patterns, land use planning, and park development.

You don't have to move to live in a better neighborhood.

What's a Neighborhood Association?

A neighborhood association (NA) is a group of residents, businesses, property owners, schools, agencies, and congregations within a designated geographic area. If you live, work, or own property in Salem, you are automatically a member of at least one NA (don't worry—there are no dues!). See map on reverse to find out which one is yours. A board elected by the NA membership meets regularly to address local issues and concerns and improve their neighborhoods. Use the information to the right or below to find out when your NA meets.

Neighborhood Associations involve residents in local decision-making that affects their neighborhood. Associations also consider and advise on issues like City budget, park improvements, land use, transportation, and crime prevention, and may organize neighborhood activities. As the other half of this partnership, City staff provide information to NAs and help connect citizens to City resources.
