The Salem Police Department collects donations of cell phones no longer wanted or needed and provides them free of charge to victims of domestic violence, sexual assault and stalking that choose to utilize them as part of a safety plan. In order to reach a 911 operator, a victim just needs a working phone. No service hookup is necessary.

Before donating, please check the following:

- Phone has a battery and charger
- Phone is unlocked and any pin numbers are erased
- Phone numbers once saved in the memory are erased (SPD does not reprogram the phone)

In the case your donation is unusable for the 911 Emergency Cell Program, the phone/parts will be recycled and sold with profits going to support services for domestic violence, sexual assault and stalking victims by the Domestic Violence Response Team program.
