**City of Salem November 2008 Streets and Bridges General Obligation Bond Measure
Total Proposed Bonding Authority: \$99.8 million**

Project Summary:

Market Street NE at Lancaster Drive NE Intersection Widening

Project Description: Widen intersection to provide dual left-turn lanes on northbound Lancaster Drive NE to westbound Market Street NE; provide dual left-turn lanes on eastbound Market Street NE to northbound Lancaster Drive NE; and widening of all approaches necessary to receive additional turn lanes. Project includes upgrading and adjusting of traffic signal and installation of other project modifications as needed.

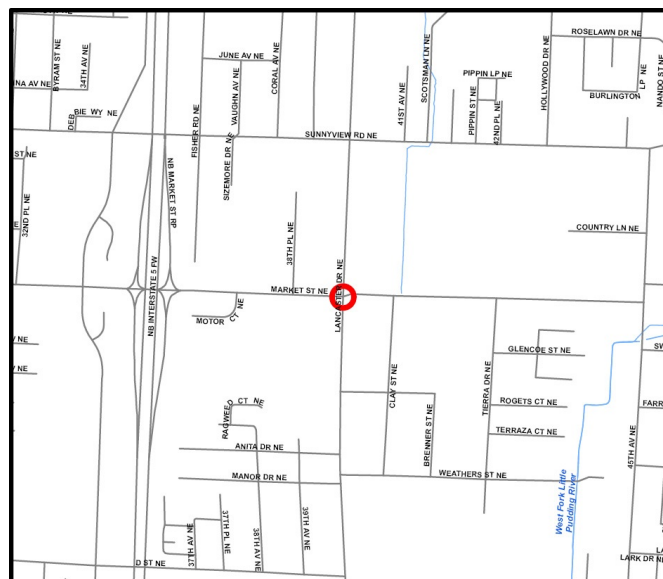
Background: Market Street NE is classified as a Major Arterial street, west of Lancaster Drive NE, and a Minor Arterial street, east of Lancaster Drive NE. Market Street NE carries approximately 10,000 vehicles per day. Lancaster Drive NE is classified as a Major Arterial street and carries approximately 35,000 vehicles per day.

Estimated Project Costs: \$8.57 million (constructed)

Draft Construction Schedule: Begin Design and Right-of-Way Acquisition: 2009
Begin Construction: 2011
