## Replacement or Rehabilitation of the Commercial Street SE Bridge over Pringle Creek

Project Description: Replace existing bridge built in 1928 due to age and deterioration with a new structure. If it is determined that the existing bridge can be successfully rehabilitated to significantly extend its life at a lower cost, the funds saved from this project are to be used to replace or rehabilitate one or more of the following bridge projects:

- Summer Street NE Bridge over Mill Creek
- Winter Street NE Bridge over Mill Creek
- Church Street SE Bridge over Pringle Creek/Shelton Ditch
- Bridge Railing and Deck Replacements on various City Bridges

Background: Commercial Street SE is classified as a Major Arterial street that carries approximately 24,000 vehicles per day.

Estimated Project Costs: \$12.2 million Total (constructed)

Draft Construction Schedule: Begin Design and Right-of-Way Acquisition: 2009  
Begin Construction: 2012
