Project Summary:

Eola Drive NW Corridor Safety Project

Project Description: Construct Eola Drive NW to Minor Arterial Street standards with center turn lane, proper travel lane widths, bicycle lanes, curbs, gutters, sidewalks, drainage, streetlights, and landscaping, as needed. Smooth and straighten curves in roadway to the extent feasible, as well as make any other project modifications as needed.

Background: Eola Drive NW is classified as a Minor Arterial street and carries approximately 6,000 vehicles per day.

Estimated Project Costs: \$6.4 million Total (constructed)

Draft Construction Schedule: Begin Design and Right-of-Way Acquisition: 2011
Begin Construction: 2012
