City of Salem November 2008 Streets and Bridges General Obligation Bond Measure
Total Proposed Bonding Authority: \$99.8 million

Project Summary:

Glen Creek Road NW at Wallace Road NW Intersection Widening

Project Description: Widen intersection to provide dual left-turn lanes on northbound Wallace Road NW to westbound Glen Creek Road NW; dual right-turn lanes on eastbound Glen Creek Road NW to southbound Wallace Road NW; right-turn-only lane on northbound Wallace Road NW to eastbound Glen Creek Road NW (if needed); and widening of both Glen Creek Road NW approaches to receive the additional turn lanes. Project to include upgrading and adjusting of traffic signal and installation of other modifications as needed.

Background: Wallace Road NW is State Highway 221, is classified as a Major Arterial street and carries 45,000 vehicles per day. Glen Creek Road NW is a City street, is classified as a Major Arterial, and carries 15,000 vehicles per day.

Estimated Project Costs: \$12.0 million Total (constructed)
\$3.4 million Federal/ODOT Funding
\$8.6 million City Bond Funding

Draft Construction Schedule: Begin Design and Right-of-Way Acquisition: 2009
Begin Construction: 2013
