

Temporary Suspension of Parking Regulation 102.045(a)

Effective July 16, 2010, per SRC 102.015, this constitutes notification of the temporary suspension of SRC 102.045(a) for 120 days with respect to enforcement as detailed below.

SRC 102.045 Prohibited Parking in Downtown Parking District

Except when authorized by a valid parking permit, the following persons may not park a motor vehicle in the Downtown Parking District on any on-street parking zone or in an off-street parking facility between the hours of 8:00a.m. and 7:00p.m.

(a) A student, during the time the student is attending class in a school.

The temporary suspension is being done while City Staff reviews and recommends a modification to the current ordinance referenced above.

Any vehicle which is subject to the above restriction will be allowed an initial 24 hours of free parking within the Downtown Parking District, after such time said vehicle is required to follow the restrictions of the Parking District, which includes purchase of parking permit for all subsequent days following the first 24 hours.

This suspension is inclusive of all City-owned off-street parking facilities within the Parking District boundaries.
