



1 No. 2006-130 approving referral of the proposed annexation of the Territory to the electors of  
2 the City at the September 19, 2006 election, as required by Salem City Charter Section 61.  
3 At the election a majority of the votes cast by the electors residing in the City favored  
4 annexation of the Territory into the City. This election result is set forth in the canvass of  
5 votes from the election reviewed by the Council at it's October 23, 2006 meeting and  
6 proclaimed by the Mayor.

7 **(d) Withdrawal from Special District.** The Council finds it is in the best interest of the  
8 City to withdraw the Territory from the Salem Suburban Rural Fire Protection District (the  
9 District) and to provide the Territory with City services because the public good of the City  
10 and the citizens residing in the Territory would be best served if the citizens residing in the  
11 Territory receive City services without the problems attendant with coordination that would  
12 result from the Territory being subject to the jurisdiction of overlapping urban service  
13 providers. It would not be in the best interest of the City for the citizens residing in the  
14 Territory to pay both City taxes and an additional assessment to the District to receive  
15 services that may readily be supplied by the City without such additional taxation. Since  
16 leaving the Territory in the District would lead to a fragmented approach to delivery of public  
17 services, unequal tax bases and resistance to cooperation, withdrawal would promote  
18 efficiency, economy and sound management in the provision of urban services for the  
19 Territory, and the Territory should be withdrawn from the District.

20 **Section 2. Annexation.** The City Council of the City of Salem declares and proclaims that the  
21 Territory described in **Exhibit 1**, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is  
22 hereby annexed to the City of Salem, Oregon.

23 **Section 3. Zoning.** The Territory is designated "Developing Residential" in the Salem Area  
24 Comprehensive Plan, and on the Plan Map. The zoning for the Territory is prescribed as RA  
25 (Residential Agriculture). The Planning Administrator shall add to the official zoning map the  
26 Territory herein annexed.

27 **Section 4. Withdrawal from the Salem Suburban Rural Fire Protection District.** The Territory  
28 is hereby withdrawn from the Salem Suburban Rural Fire Protection District, such withdrawal to be

Beginning at a point on the South Line of Lot 53, Sunnyside Fruit Farms No. 3, as recorded in Volume 2, Page 35, Book of Town Plats, Marion County, Oregon; said point being 181.10 feet South 89° 32' 21" East from the quarter corner common to Sections 16 and 21; and running thence:

South 89° 32' 21" East 352.00 feet to the southeast corner of that tract of land described in that instrument recorded in Reel 2390, Page 414, Marion County Records;  
thence North 00° 25' 00" East 165.34 feet along the East Line of said Reel 2390, Page 414, to the northeast corner thereof; said point being on the now existing City Limits Line;  
thence North 89° 43' 31" West 354.68 feet along the North Line of said Reel 2390, Page 414, and the now existing City Limits Line to the northwest corner thereof;  
thence South 01° 12' 21" East 165.05 feet along the West Line of said Reel 2390, Page 414, to the Point of Beginning.
