


SUBJECT: DUII Enforcement Grant Renewal Request

ISSUE:

Should the City of Salem re-apply for, and accept, a Driving Under the Influence of Intoxicants (DUII) Overtime Enforcement grant?

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends Council authorize the Salem Police Department to apply for, and accept, a renewal of a DUII Overtime Enforcement grant in the amount of up to \$18,000.

BACKGROUND:

This is a federal grant that covers \$40.00 per hour for overtime enforcement of DUII. The Salem Police Department has applied for, and been awarded, this grant for over 10 years. The monies have, and will allow the department to increase their enforcement efforts of DUII during night time patrols.

FACTS & FINDINGS:

1. During federal FY 06-07, the Salem Police Department received a DUII Overtime Enforcement grant for \$15,000 to cover overtime expenses during the enforcement of DUII.
2. During federal FY 06-07, over 30 DUII driver's were arrested by officers working on overtime funded by this grant.
3. The grant allows overtime officers to take DUII arrests from patrol officers, freeing the patrol officer for routine patrol activities and to respond to emergency calls.
4. There is a soft match requirement of any resource used to facilitate the overtime, such as scheduling, reporting of statistics, maintenance of patrol vehicles, etc. The City would meet that match through our normal, day to day traffic patrol duties.
