### **Principles**

- Every customer, visitor and employee is a pedestrian at some point.
  - Transportation throughput is critical to the health and vibrancy of the Core.

- Balance demand for transport of goods and services to, through and beyond the Core with the need for thriving businesses, pockets of open and play space, and peaceful gathering places
- Develop vibrant, active, and pedestrian scale amenities to enhance pedestrian experience at the sidewalk and street level
- Connect welcoming, safe and easy to find passage ways, trails and view corridors along Core Area waterways
- Enhance direct, frequent, and reliable connections for visitor and employee access to the Core, including linking transit options with parking
- Advocate for stronger transportation options to connect the Core with the rest of the city and surrounding region
- Create visually appealing and distinct entrances to the Core
- Reduce appearance of traffic and parking congestion
  - Enhance incentives for employee use of park and rides, shared commutes, and Transit
  - Prepare long range parking management plan (to include financing), taking into account future core area development and partnerships
