

# **Notice of Public Hearing**

## **Proposed Update to the City of Salem Water and Wastewater System Development Charge (SDC) Methodology**

THE SALEM CITY COUNCIL will hold a public hearing at 6:30 p.m., Monday, February 4, 2008, in the City Council Chambers, Civic Center, Salem, Oregon, to receive testimony on a proposed update to the Water and Wastewater System Development Charge (SDC) Methodology. The principal purpose of the update is to reflect the updated project lists set forth by the recently adopted Water System Master Plan Amendment (May 2007), Willow Lake Wastewater Treatment Plant Facilities Plan (September 2002), and the Wastewater Management Master Plan Amendment (January 2007). The current methodology dates back to 1998, and warrants updating to reflect not only the major water and wastewater construction that has occurred over the ensuing decade, but the legislative amendments to the Oregon statutes governing SDCs. The proposed methodology will be available at the City Recorder's Office, Civic Center, 555 Liberty Street SE, Room 205, Salem, OR 97301, at least sixty (60) days prior to the public hearing.
