1. Issue: Public Hearing for a proposed “NO TRUCK PARKING; LOADING EXCEPTED.” Public Works is requesting that CATC recommend an action to stop truck storage on public streets while maintaining legitimate parking uses for local businesses.

Action: Approved - “No Truck Parking; Loading Excepted and approved additional Loading Zone area” on 32nd Place NE from Market Street NE to Madison Street NE and Lansing Avenue NE from Market Street NE to Madison Street NE

2. Issue: Elections of Chair and Vice Chair.

6. Information Items:

A. ORDER 1918

ISSUE:

Residents on the west side of High Street SE, between Judson Street SE and McGilchrist Street SE, are negatively impacted by commuter vehicles and have requested residential parking on their side of High Street SE.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

The west side of High Street SE, between Judson Street SE and McGilchrist Street SE, be signed as 90-minute parking, 7AM-6PM, Monday thru Friday, RP-50 excepted.

B. ORDER 1919

ISSUE:

Due to the high demand of parking in the area, additional unrestricted parking has been requested on the north side of McGilchrist Street SE, between East Nob Hill Street SE and High Street SE.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

The existing posted parking restrictions on the north side of McGilchrist Street SE, between East Nob Hill Street SE and High Street SE, be removed to allow unrestricted parking (existing yellow curb to remain).
