Rooted in the belief that no one should feel forgotten or alone, the **Friendship Brigade** is an innovative, new community care and nursing home visitation program.

Our purpose is to recruit, train and connect caring volunteers with isolated seniors living in local long term care facilities. We're also here to help friends and family learn how to better connect and be present for their aging parents or loved ones.

BUILDING CONNECTIONS

Although surrounded by nursing staff and other residents, many elders and disabled adults living in care and nursing facilities feel set-apart from the outside world and disconnected from friends or family. Many have no one at all.

Without social interaction and the benefits of friendship, life in a facility often feels hopeless. The **Friendship Brigade** wants to change all that!

How it works: Volunteers provide company, reassurance, and friendship while engaging residents in one-on-one and group activities.

Time commitment: 1 or 2 hours per week for at least 6 months.
