## Storm Siren trilogy (#1—*Storm Siren*)

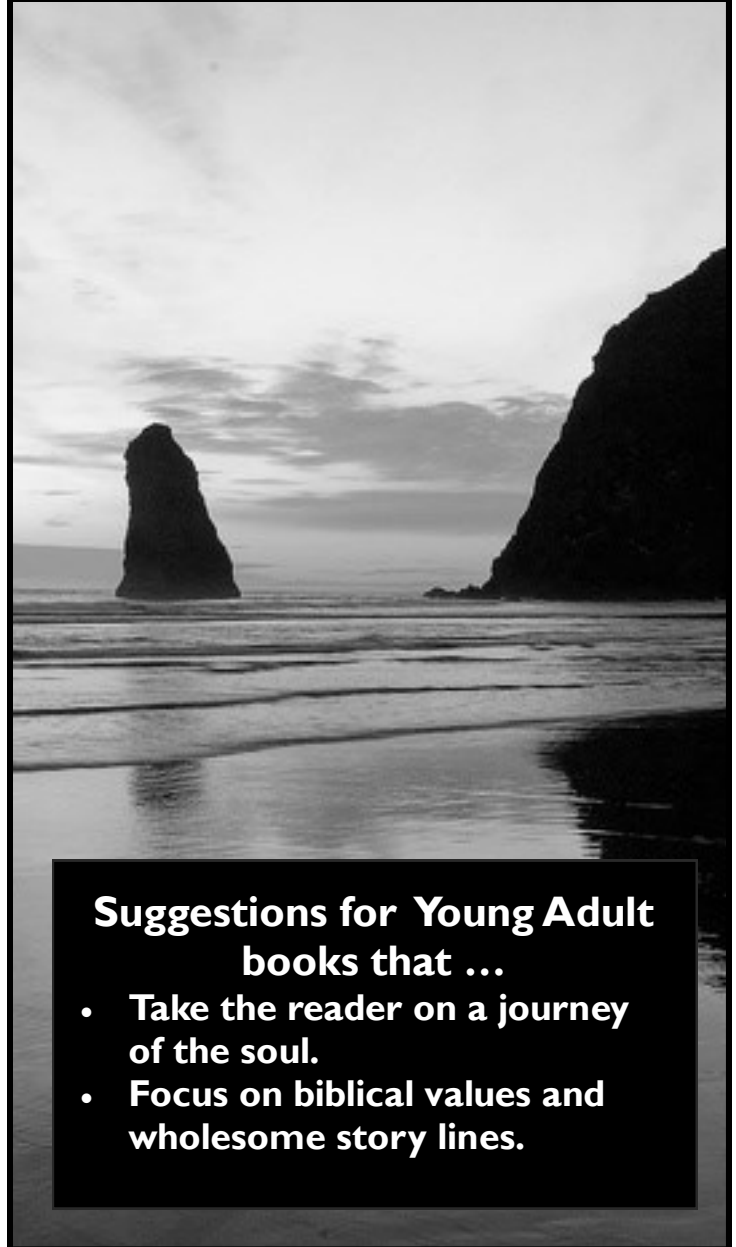
